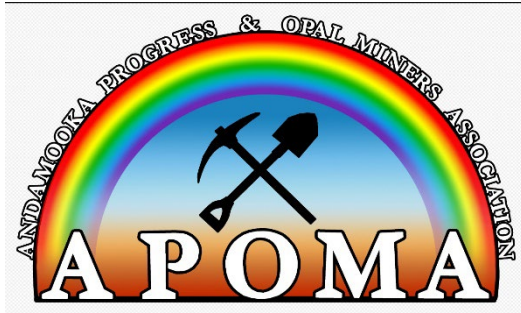




Community Survey
